Fairtrade Easter Eggs. The Real Easter Egg is the only one sold in the UK that tells the story of Easter. For every egg sold, a donation is made to Traidcraft exchange as well as the Fairtrade premium, supporting life-changing work in the most vulnerable communities. A selection of eggs will be available to purchase on the Fairtrade stall at the west end of the church. You may like to consider donating £5.00 for an egg. These donations will be given to four local charities: Brian House, Children’s Centre, Homestart and Foodbank to share the Christian message with local families. This is a Fylde Fairtrade initiative supported by Fylde churches. Easter cards and crosses are also available on the stall.
