Remembrance Sunday is next Sunday, 12th November. On this occasion, there will be only one morning service at 9.00a.m. This will offer a tribute to the fallen in wars across the world. The timing of the service will later allow those who attend to witness the procession and to be present at the Remembrance Day service held at the War Memorial in Lytham.

Prayer for Wholeness and Healing, In James 5, vv 13-16, we read, 'Is anyone among you in trouble? Let them pray. Is anyone happy? Let them sing songs of praise. Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the

sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven. Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.'

Since it is the first weekend in November, we carry on this tradition with individual prayer for Wholeness and Healing with the Laying on of Hands and Anointing with Oil.
